About the Indigenous History and Heritage Gathering (IHHG)

IHHG, hosted by the National Centre for Truth and Reconciliation (NCTR) and the First Nations Confederacy of Cultural Education Centres (FNCCEC), welcomes members of Inuit and Métis communities and First Nations, as well as cultural professionals, academics, media, government employees, and anyone involved in researching Indigenous histories and presenting inclusive stories. Guided by addresses from Indigenous changemakers and visionaries, the conference is a space to examine the many ways that history has been used as a tool of colonialism and to envision a better path forward.

The inaugural IHHG held in Ottawa in June 2023, welcomed over 350 attendees from across Canada. The participants worked in a variety of fields related to Indigenous history, heritage, and culture including museums, Indigenous governments, municipalities, cultural centres, and federal departments. Over half of the delegates self-identified as Métis, Inuit, or First Nations.

IHHG 2024 Program

Participants at IHHG will see case studies of cutting-edge heritage projects and hear from experts on how to create meaningful projects that bring historical truths to the forefront. Exhibitors at the Indigenous History and Heritage Gathering will add to the rich program built on the following program streams:

Residential and Day Schools

This stream will focus on ongoing efforts to uncover and share truths about both the day school and residential school systems. It will contribute to ongoing discussion about identifying and commemorating missing children and unmarked burials.

Relevant Topics: Case studies from ongoing work, statement gathering, history of day schools, search technologies (Lidar, GPR, etc.), archival research, mapping

Preserving Language and Culture

Participants will learn about best practices and emerging methods for preserving language and culture. This can include Indigenous-owned and operated archives and collections, digital repositories, or other innovative ways to store and preserve cultural assets and language.

Relevant Topics: The importance of preserving Indigenous languages, digital language libraries, collections management (how to organize and provide access to artifacts), digital cultural resources

Sharing Stories

This stream will showcase innovative storytelling methods that have been used to share and preserve Indigenous histories.

Relevant Topics: Documentaries, podcasts, museum exhibits, books/articles, virtual reality

Land Back

This stream will explore the historic and contemporary Land Back movement. Presenters will speak about practical ways their Nation asserts its rights and fights for reconciliation.

Relevant Topics: Contemporary and historic land back movements, importance of land, history of Treaties, Beans (film)
